ROSENBERG, Texas (December 18, 2018) — On Tuesday, December 18, 2018, OCuSOFT sponsored the 2018 Annual Holiday Celebration at Fort Bend Seniors Meals on Wheels (FBS). The event took place at the Bud O’Shieles Community Center in Rosenberg with seniors from across Fort Bend and Waller counties in attendance.

This annual celebration is the official holiday event for Fort Bend Seniors and featured games of bingo, raffle drawings, and holiday carols. OCuSOFT employees donated their time and served a holiday lunch catered by Lomonte’s Italian Restaurant to more than 200 seniors along with FBS Board Members. Community members and groups, including First United Methodist Church of Rosenberg, donated blankets and small gifts of slippers, lotions, socks, blankets, crosswords and more for raffle and bingo prizes.
