After nearly 15 months of closing the doors due to the pandemic, our **Bud O'Shieles Community Center**, located in Rosenberg, welcomed seniors back with smiles and hugs all around on Monday, June 7. Activities offered at this and each of FBS' congregate centers include bingo, art and fitness classes, along with a hot meal and socialization that was sorely missed during the pandemic.

As we enter the hot summer months, more seniors from across the county will have the opportunity to gather in the A/C at a center near them. One of two **NEW** locations, the **Landmark Community Center** - located at 100 Louisiana St., Missouri City - will open Monday. The reopening schedule for remaining congregate centers is as follows:

- June 28 - Kendleton, Huntington at Sienna, and Fort Bend YMCA
- Early July - Brookshire - United Way Waller Center
- Early August - **NEW LOCATION:** Four Corners Community Center

As we work towards fully reopening all of our centers, we will continue to follow all health guidelines and recommendations to ensure the continued safety of our seniors, volunteers, and staff members. 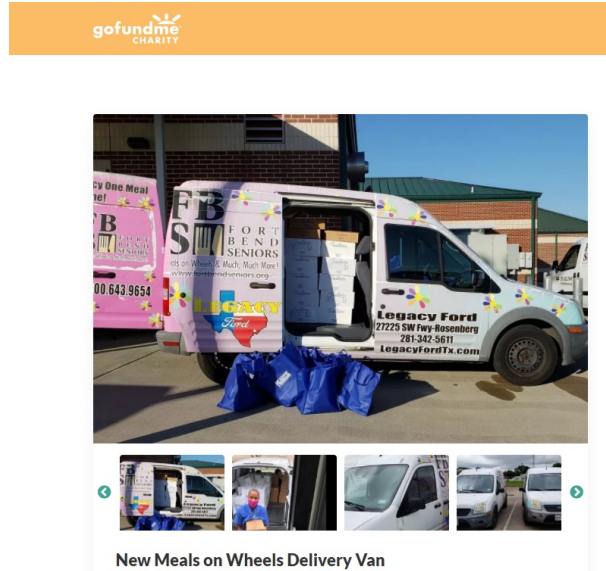

At Fort Bend Seniors Meals on Wheels we operate a fleet of 9 meal delivery vans across 2 counties in Texas with - some routes clocking up to 220 miles a day! Last year we transitioned to weekly deliveries of frozen meals to more than 2,100 homebound seniors, serving a record **438,000 meals!**
